- A written reference
- One video recording (presented by Youtube, Vimeo etc) of a recent (within 6 months) recording of a work of Bach or Handel.

AUDITION SCHEDULE

Successful applicants will be required to present the following repertoire:

First Calls: 18 & 19 January 2023

Repertoire: One baroque (Bach or Handel) aria, one classical aria

Candidates are able to elect a preference for one of the two dates. Please note, although we will do our best to factor in your preference we cannot guarantee we will be able to offer you an audition on this date.

Second Calls: 2 & 3 February 2023

Repertoire: One aria from a Bach cantata, one aria from a Handel oratorio (but not the Messiah), one classical aria

Final Calls: 10 March 2023

One aria from a Bach cantata, one aria from a Handel oratorio (but not the Messiah), one classical aria, one English song

Each work presented may be repeated once in the audition process (not including the video submission).

A pianist will be provided for each round.

The panel might only call for one piece in an audition or hear part of a work.
